Features

- 1. Length of the tunnel is 9.02 kms
- 2. It is the longest highway tunnel in the world
- 3. It connects Manali to Lahaul-Spiti valley throughout the year. Earlier the valley was cut-off for 6 months due to snowfall.
- 4. It is built in the Pir Panjal mountains at a height of 3000 meters.
- 5. The tunnel reduces the road distance by 46 Kms between Manali and Leh and the time by about 4 to 5 hours.
- 6. It was earlier named Rohtang tunnel
